Other notes regarding show entries:

1. Group classes, Junior Owned & Showmanship entries will be accepted at the show.
2. Substitutions must be received by Nov 2, 2017. Substitutions must be an animal of the same sex and must share the same birth month
3. Exhibitors/owners must be active, associate or junior members of the EAA or will not be allowed to compete in the show.
5. All bulls, 15 months old or older on show day, must have proof of a satisfactory semen test, performed by a licensed Veterinarian, within 90 days of the show.
6. All females 20 months of age or older must be confirmed pregnant within 90 days of the show or have a natural calf at their side.
7. Only 2017 natural born calves still nursing their dam, are allowed to compete in the cow/calf classes.
8. Any and all cattle shall be made available to have hair pulled for parentage verification
9. All cattle and stall areas must be presented in a professional attractive manner.
10. **All entries must be paid prior to the show!**
